

## **Texans dominate Division 3 with 8-0 record in Hamilton PAL play this fall**

Don't mess with them Texans, partner.

The Texans rolled to an 8-0 record this year to finish in first place in Division 3 of the Hamilton PAL Football League.

The team was coached by George Kloutis (offense/special teams), Brian Melnick (offense/defense) and Jim Pine (defense). They outscored their eight opponents by a combined 190-25, shut out five foes (the defense allowed just 13 points) and held them to a combined 315 yards (an average of just under 40 yards per game)

Only the Chargers scored in double figures against the Texans in a season-ending 27-13 loss. The Texans had 10 takeaways, including seven fumble recoveries and three interceptions.

The team's statistical leaders were Dariyon Evans (575 yards, 9 touchdowns), Jake Muller (435 yards, 8 TDs, 13 extra points), Colin Hendrix (285 yards, 3 TDs, 2 extra points, 1 KO return for a TD), Danny Melnick (265 yards, 2 TDs, 2 extra points), Nick Kloutis (110 yards, 1 TD) and Gennaro Salzano (2 TDs, 155 yards).
