Spartans top WW-Plainsboro South to splash into holidays with 6-0 record

Dec. 22: The Steinert High boys' swim team certainly put itself in a festive mood for the holidays today.

The red-hot Spartans improved their record to 6-0 by taking an 88.5-81.5 victory over West Windsor-Plainsboro South in a meet that came down to the 400 free relay.

The Spartans pulled it out when Tommy Wright, Kyle Gulsby, Kevin Diefenbach and Zach Mabin clocked a first-place time of 3:33.87 to give Steinert the necessary 10 points it needed for the win.

Diefenbach also took first in the 50-yard freestyle in 23.73 and the 100 free in 52.15, while Mabin won the 200 free in 1:51.77 and 100 breaststroke in 1:04.05. Wright also took first in the 500 freestyle (5:21.24) while the 200 free relay team of Tyler Gulsby, Frank Sun, Gary Liedtka-Bizuga and Wright took first in 1:39.20.

The always formidable WWPS dropped to 2-4.
