Adams says: We've got big holes to fill at wide receiver and the skill positions. We lost some talented young men there. We're green and young at the skill positions but we're very talented. But we do have Esayah Obado back at quarterback and he's coming off a strong season. Nobody works harder than Esayah. It starts with him and ends with him. He's gonna take us on his big shoulders literally. He's put on a lot of good weight, worked hard in the off-season conditioning program. He's our leader, we'll go as far as he takes us. I'd just like to see him exude some more leadership qualities at times.

Esayah is the only skill player other than Kamara who's seen any varsity action. We're a little young there but we're very explosive and talented.

Sometimes when you put young guys out there they're not exactly in the right spot at the right time. So we're gonna try to eliminate that. If we can we'll be in good shape.

Defensively Dennis "The Menace" Hernandez is back. He's always around the ball making a play here and there to help us win ball games. Dennis

will anchor our defensive line along with Tyree Patterson. We've got a good football team, we just have to be patient with our kids and understand we have new guys out there and it will take a little while. The quicker we jell as a team the better off we're gonna be.
